There are only about 30,000 Xoloitzcuintli in the world, and there are only about 3000 in the US. Due to perceived extinction and scarcity, it was removed from the AKC studbook in 1959. To register Xolo with the AKC, the Xoloitzcuintli Club of America (XCA) was later established. Thanks to its efforts, Xolo was reinstated in the AKC studbook in 2010.

Due to the rarity of Xolo we are working on a new concept known as **TOKEN FOR GOOD**. Its purpose is to retain the amount of Xoloitzcuintli dogs in the world as well as to save them from extinction.
