

NEST Token Replacement on Ethereum

Due to a hacker attack on Poly Network [in July](#), where the hacker maliciously issued a large amount of NEST tokens, to protect the interests of all NEST token holders, we have decided to replace the NEST token contract on the Ethereum network with NEST 2.0.

Refrain from engaging in any transactions associated with the hacker address or using the exchanges related to the hacker's address

Avoid purchasing NEST tokens on Ethereum-based DEXs (such as Uniswap, 1inch, and other decentralized exchanges)

Please take note of the following:

1. The old contract will be deprecated, and all holders must replace the old NEST for NEST2.0.
2. A single address can only submit a request for a replacement token once.

 - c. Your replacement request will be manually reviewed at :
 - o August 18 ~ September 2: Once a day
 - o September 3 ~ September 16: Once on every Friday
 - o After September 16: Once on the last business day of every month
