CUDOS Completes Token Merger with ASI

Today, CUDOS and the Artificial Superintelligence (ASI) Alliance are pleased to announce that the token and blockchain merger has now been successfully and fully completed. To recap, what happened today is:

- The CUDOS mainnet halted at height 12,385,627, and it will never produce blocks again.
- All the data from the CUDOS final state was exported.
- The Fetch.ai (ASI) chain performed a software upgrade with all the CUDOS data to convert and move all balances.
- All CUDOS token holders and delegators successfully migrated, along with 30 CUDOS validators. The new validator count in Fetch.ai's (ASI) mainnet is 91.

This marks the last step in the CUDOS merger with the ASI Alliance. As a reminder, all CUDOS holders are now able to see their new \$FET tokens in a Fetch.ai (ASI) mainnet such as <u>Mintscan</u>. To verify you have the right amount in your vesting schedule, you can look at a CUDOS explorer that's still active (<u>CUDOS explorer</u> or <u>Mintscan</u>), and your \$FET balance should be that amount divided by 118.344.
