Changes in Ledger Live

In Ledger Live version 1.19 the following changes take effect:

- The ERC20 token previously known as Dai, will be listed as Dai Stablecoin v1.0 (SAI). The contract address remains <u>0x89d24a6b4ccb1b6faa2625fe562bdd9a23260359</u>. Dai holders will find their coins will be listed as SAI.
- A new ERC20 token will be listed as Dai Stablecoin v2.0 (DAI).
 The contract address is <u>0x6b175474e89094c44da98b954eedeac495271d0f</u>. Original Dai (SAI) holders can migrate to the new Dai using <u>Maker's migration tool</u>.
